


What it Does

Dejero Intercom enables real-time two-way audio communication between a Dejero EnGo 260 mobile transmitter and a Dejero WayPoint 50 or 104 receiver in the station. The Dante Virtual Soundcard allows you to use audio over an IP connection.



Using the Intercom feature with EnGo

- The Intercom feature is available when the EnGo 260 is ready to transmit live or when transmitting live.
- The Logitech H390 headset must be connected to the EnGo to use the feature. Audio is only transmitted when the headset is connected.
- With the headset connected, audio meters appear on the right side of the EnGo preview screen.



Intercom works independently of one-way IFB, offering the ability to have an IFB channel for talent and a two-way Intercom channel for the camera operator.

Requirements

Software	Dante Virtual Soundcard license from Audinate (installed on WayPoint)
